

The Mike Sakamoto Memorial Scholarship Scholarship Application



Introduction:

The Mike Sakamoto Memorial Scholarship was developed by the Pacific Islands Fisheries Group (a 501c3 non-profit corporation) in memory of local fishing icon, Mike Sakamoto. A tireless advocate for the sport of fishing, Sakamoto dedicated much of his life to ensuring the preservation of fishing rights. This scholarship was conceived with his philosophy of responsible fishing in mind.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. A graduating high school senior, applying as a full-time student to an accredited four-year college or university in the United States to earn a baccalaureate degree. (Full-time shall be defined as a minimum of 12 credit-hours per semester.)
2. Must be a U.S. citizen and legal resident of Hawaii.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Scholarship applications are available through your school guidance counselor or on our website at www.fishtoday.org.
2. Complete the application form.
3. Enclose a copy of your high school transcript.
4. Complete the essay questions.
5. Send in all completed forms by February 28, 2010. No exceptions.
6. Interviews will be conducted in the months of March/April.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

1. Intent to major in marine sciences, oceanography, or other field related to fisheries.
2. Ocean-related hobbies/interest (i.e. fishing, diving, etc.)
3. Personal involvement and/or interest in the fishing community.
